

Strategically located to be the natural gateway to the Gulf












ANCIENT BAHRAIN

On Arrival Visa 66 countries are eligible to apply for visas on-arrival.



Not eligible for eVisa, Don't Worry

If you do not meet the criteria for a Visit eVisa, you may still be eligible for a visa.

Almost all delegates will require a visa to visit Bahrain. Early application is recommended. BSAA can provide booking assistance with the visa application.
