Denmark	<p>In Denmark port charges are publicly available tariffs. The ports are obliged to publish new rates and charges with minimum two Months notification. Great Britain	<p>The UK does not have any national ports it is a mix of mainly privately owned, local authority owned and trust ports. Then, it could happen that a named agent has commercial discounts due to volume etc</p> <p>The Port fees are included in the Country National Budget (Presupuestos general del Estado 762 pages), with 3 levels:</p>

Turkey	<p>In Turkey, port expenses such as pilotage, towage, berth dues and all port related services, light dues, sanitary dues tariffs are available only upon request.</p> <p>Generally no tariffs are publicly available.</p>
