
- Ukraine tanker market disruption – longer supply chain

- Efuels?






Conflict deaths have been rising since 2005





DRY BULK CONGESTION BY VESSEL TYPE (DWT)


(09 Oct 2023; DAILY DATA; LAST 3 YEARS)



Congestion is marginally lower compared to last year.

In 2022, on average 1694 units were cought up with congestion, that is 15% of the dry bulk fleet.

In 2023, 1593 units... Around 14% of the fleet. 2023 figures are very similar to 2021, an excellent year.




Australian Coal Exports to China

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Dry Bulk Trade - Quarterly - Last 3 years










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
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






CRUDE OIL PRICES




