

INTRODUCTION:

FONASBA – the Federation of National Associations of Ship Brokers and Agents has established the Young Ship Agent or Shipbroker Award since 2015.

This prestigious award is conferred to the author of the best original paper submitted from a young professional [under 40] within the framework and deadlines indicated below.

FONASBA invites submissions for the 2024 YABA - FONASBA YOUNG SHIP AGENT OR SHIPBROKER OF THE YEAR AWARD for original unpublished papers addressing the challenges and opportunities within the professions of Shipbrokers and Ship Agents.

PURPOSE OF THE FONASBA AWARD:

The aim of the Award is to develop professionalism among young people in ship agency and shipbroking and to encourage them to be actively engaged in the industry. A further objective of the Award is to enhance FONASBA's academic resources.

AUTHOR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The author shall be 40 years of age or under at the time of submission of the paper to the Review Committee. Entries are welcome from all eligible individuals employed by a company that is a member of a FONASBA Full, or Candidate Member association, or by an Associate or Club Member; and from external authors, who are employed elsewhere [companies that are not part of the FONSABA network].

PAPER CRITERIA:

The paper should present a comprehensive analysis of the role of the ship agent or shipbroker in a specific field or market sector. Candidates may wish to write on a specific shipping market (for example dry bulk, tanker, liner, passenger or offshore shipping or sale and purchase), another sector of the international maritime industry such a ship management or alternatively on a broader topic such as "New business opportunities in a changing shipping world" or "The profession of the ship agent (and or) ship broker in 2025".

The paper should be written in such a way as to be understood by both professionals in the field as well as general (non-maritime) readers.

To ensure consistently high standards, the subject of the paper will be agreed between the author and the Review Committee prior to work starting.

In a first instance, the author will be invited to submit the title and a brief summary [between 350 and 500 words] outlining the scope and contents of the work to the Committee for review and comment.

The Review Committee may suggest such changes to the proposal as it feels appropriate to ensure the finished work meets the required standards.



After the scope of the work has been agreed, the formal entry will comprise a formal written paper (illustrated where appropriate) to a minimum of 5,000, maximum 10,000 words, excluding the title, indices, footnotes and bibliography. The paper will be written in English. The paper shall be an original work and shall not have been published in print or electronic media prior to being submitted for the Award. The editorial guidelines regarding the paper layout, visual content management, etc. will be circulated in due course.

The timetable for entering a paper to the Award scheme is provided overleaf.

OWNERSHIP/PUBLICATION OF ALL PAPERS:

Copyright of the paper remains with the author but in entering for the Award, the author agrees that the work will be made available to the membership and the public via the FONASBA website, publications, and other communication media.

REVIEW PROCESS:

All aspects of the review process and selection of the winner of the Award will be undertaken by a Review Committee comprised of the following:

- A senior member of FONASBA as Chair, nominated by the Executive Committee
- The Vice President for Education
- Up to two further individuals nominated by the Executive Committee

The Review Committee will be supported by the FONASBA Secretariat which will administer all aspects of the Award scheme, including all communication with the authors.

AWARDING OF YOUNG AGENT/BROKER TITLE:

The Review Committee will consider all papers received by the closing date shown below and select the best entry.

PRIZES*:

*Owing to the generous support from our esteemed partners, we are in the privileged position to offer not one, but two exceptional awards this year, expanding our recognition beyond the customary first prize to include a second prize as well.

The winner of the <u>first prize</u> will receive the following, courtesy of FONASBA, its Club Members ITIC and BIMCO and the Barcelona Ship Agents' Association, ACB: cash awards of \leq 1,000 from FONASBA and \leq 500.00 from ITIC, complimentary access to a BIMCO e-Learning module of their choice and complimentary entry into either the FONASBA ACB Liner Shipping Transportation or Tramp Shipping course. They will also receive a certificate recognising their achievement.

The <u>first prize</u> winner will have the opportunity to present their work at the Annual Meeting scheduled for October 2024 in Athens, Greece.



The winner of the <u>second prize</u> will receive the following, courtesy of Fonasba members in the USA, ASBA, complimentary entry into their course on Shipbrokering & Charter Vessel Operations (SBCVO).

The certificates and prizes will be sent by FONASBA for presentation locally. News of the awards will be publicised in the maritime media and via the FONASBA website, publications, and other communication media.

AUTHOR AND REVIEW COMMITTEE TIMETABLE:

Step 1.

Submission of the paper abstract including the concept of the paper. To be presented alongside the name, age, email address and company contact details of the author, together with the title and a short (350 – 500 word) summary of the scope and contents of the paper to be submitted to the Review Committee via the FONASBA Secretariat (generalmanager@fonasba.com) by 15th April 2024.

Step 2.

Review Committee to reply to the author, accepting the proposed paper, or suggesting amendments, by 3rd May 2024.

Step 3.

Completed papers to be returned to the Review Committee, via the FONASBA Secretariat, by 19th July 2024.

Step 4.

The Review Committee will select and announce the winner by 30th August 2024.
