The Jordan Shipping Association (JSA) has been actively engaged in 2025 in strengthening the maritime and logistics sector in Jordan through training, official visits, participation in national and international events, and enhanced cooperation with governmental and private stakeholders. Below is a summary of the Association's main activities and achievements:

**Training and Capacity Building**

- Organized specialized training courses on *Cargo Claims and Insurance*.
- Delivered a training course entitled *Fundamentals of Maritime Transport*.
- Conducted a training program on the *ASYHUB System* of the Jordan Customs Department.
- Held a professional course on *Marine Insurance*.
- Organized a dedicated course on *Letters of Credit in International Trade*.
- Held a specialized training course on cyber security

**Committees and Sector Dialogue**

- The Containers Committee convened several meetings to discuss sector challenges, including issues with clearance companies and NVOCC operations, and to provide practical solutions.
- A cooperative meeting was held with the Association of Owners of Clearance and Transport Companies to enhance coordination and improve collaboration
- The RORO Committee held a meeting to discuss sector challenges.

**Official Visits and Engagements**

- The JSA Board of Directors paid official visits to key governmental authorities, including the Ministry of Transport and the Jordan Customs Department, where it met with the Director.
- A series of visits were conducted in Aqaba to major institutions, including:
  - Aqaba Special Economic Zone Authority (ASEZA) and Aqaba Development Corporation.
  - Aqaba Port Marine Services Company.
  - Aqaba Port Management and Operation Company.



- Jordan Maritime Commission.
- Aqaba Container Terminal.
- Aqaba Logistics Village.
- Aqaba Customs Department.

These visits helped strengthen communication, cooperation, and problem-solving with stakeholders in the maritime and logistics sector.

### **Participation in National and International Events**

- Actively participated in the *Ninth Maritime Day* events held in Aqaba.
- Took part in the *Middle East and North Africa Tourism Conference* in Amman.
- Represented the sector at the *Transport Middle East 2025* event.
- Participated in the *FONASBA Council Meeting* held in Egypt

### **Internal Activities**

- Held the *39th Annual General Assembly Meeting* and elected a new Board of Directors.
- Continued outreach through visits to association members to enhance communication and address operational challenges.
- Regularly published *monthly statistics* on the shipping sector in Jordan.

### **Other Contributions**

- The Secretary-General of JSA, Captain Mohammad Al-Dalabeeh, participated in sectoral working sessions at the Prime Ministry to prepare the second executive program of the *Economic Modernization Vision 2026–2029*, with a focus on transport and logistics.
- Prepared a questionnaire, in coordination with FONASBA, regarding longstanding DG containers, to be submitted to Jordanian authorities for consideration.
